### Dental Appointments

#### New Patient £85

45 minute appointment including:

- 14 point dental health examination (full and detailed examination of the whole mouth)
- Oral cancer screen
- Advice on keeping your mouth very healthy.

#### Existing Patient £54

Regular review and monitoring of dental health including:

- 14 point dental health examination
- Oral cancer screen.

#### X-rays (Radiograph) £12.50 each

Ultra low exposure digital radiographs are not always necessary but we charge an additional fee if they are required.

#### Restorative Fillings from £130

Dependent on tooth size and materials

#### Root Canal Treatment from £350

Dependent on number of roots

#### Crowns & Inlays/Onlays

from £680

#### Teeth Whitening £380

#### Veneers from £740 (per veneer)

#### Extractions from £120

Based on location and number of roots

#### Dentures

Determined by materials, laboratory bill, number of teeth and complexity.

from £450

**Cobalt chrome (metal) denture:**  
from £1150
